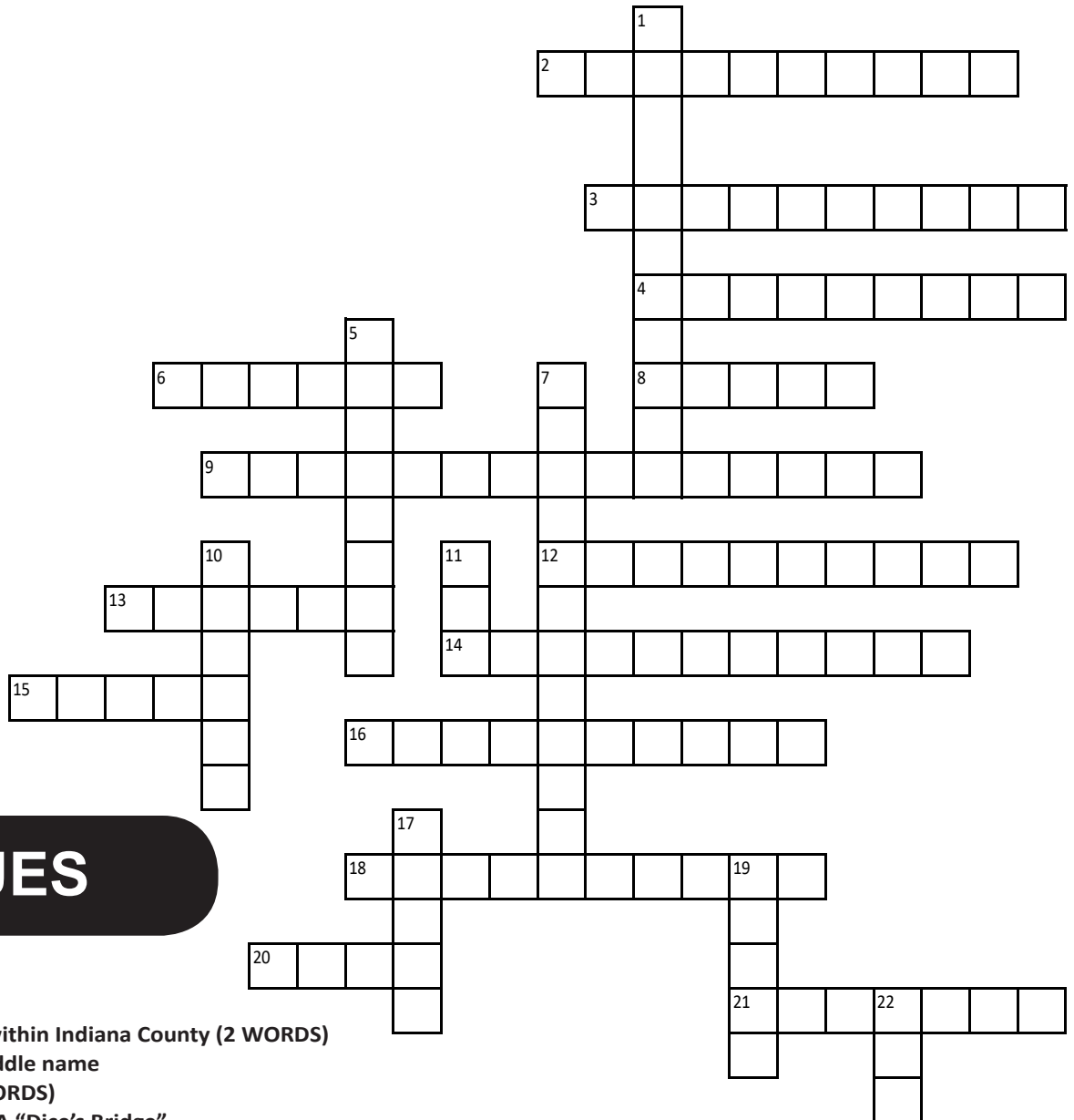


# INDIANA COUNTY, PA CROSSWORD

### DOWN

1. State park located within Indiana County (2 WORDS)

7. Mascot of IUP (2 WORDS)

11. Before becoming a US President, he campaigned through Indiana in 1960 and delivered a speech in front of the old courthouse
17. The "Rest on Arms" statue is located in front of \_\_\_\_\_ House in Indiana
19. The "Rest on Arms" statue pays tribute to Indiana County veterans that served in this war
22. Abbreviation for college located in Indiana County

2. A monument located in this town designates the northern corner of the historic Indian land purchase made by the Fort Stanwix Treaty (2 WORDS)
3. The IUP University Museum is located inside of this hall, which was built in 1875 and is a nationally-registered historic landmark (2 WORDS)

6. Covered bridge that crosses Crooked Creek
8. This furnace holds the unique distinction of being one of only a few furnaces in US to still have its original heat exchanger piping

13. Covered bridge named after a Civil War veteran and spans Plum Creek and near Trusal covered bridge
