# 2 - Remembered and Never Forgotten

This mural shows admiration and respect to the original people who lived on this land. Dedicated to the woman and child that were excavated here in Blairsville. The graffiti piece says Souls, which is the artist's name. Souls wanted to bring well painted graffiti to the area to show that this art form is beautiful, important and perhaps the largest art movement in history. If it wasn't for graffiti, all of these murals wouldn't exist.
